CHALLENGES

Our global client was in the middle of a remediation process. They were struggling with:

- Inconsistent global procedures
- Poor Validation Knowledge & Culture globally Siloed sites and business lines
- Over 47 sites with multiple languages



THE DANGER

But that's not all. Sustainable learning wasn't just "nice to have" - it was essential. Without it, the client was susceptible to:

- Patient safety risks
- Non-compliant standards & open to regulatory challenges

INTERVENTION

- Established a team of validation and instructional design experts
- Completed Value-Learning outcome mapping Carried out gap analysis on GSOP
- Developed 8 micro-learning eLearning modules on process validation in multiple languages



THE OUTCOME

The results speak for themselves:

- Resolution of the 483 finding
- All global employees were trained within 30 days Processes were streamlined
- Sustainable knowledge was developed in a sustainable way
- New global procedures and gap assessments were created
